The pond in the vicarage garden looked small and shallow; it had yellow flag iris and a little water. The iris were beautiful but kept spreading and were impossible to pull up or thin out. Now my gardener has been able to clear the pond (as you can see to the left) and I can now see it is much bigger and deeper than I thought.

I am getting a new liner for the pond and am looking forward to refilling it and planting new slow growing plants so that it is restored and becomes again a pond with water and wild life, rather than a bed of iris.(though not as large as the Bridge Pond!)

When I looked at my emerging pond it reminded me that things can gradually fill our lives, crowding out our relationship with God. That our lives can become full of a habit or custom we never intended. If this happens Jesus calls to follow him again, worshipping God and living in fellowship. So that we become more and more the person God created us to be, made in God's image to reflect his glory in the world.
