Lest we forget

Remembrance is important to me for many reasons. It is good to have a time when we can remember and give thanks for those who have gone before us, who we loved and miss. In this season of remembrance we first remember those who have died, giving thanks for their lives and their witness to God's love shown in Christ on All Saints and All Souls. Now on

this Sunday our remembrance turns to those who died as a result of war and conflict when serving in the Army, Navy, Air Force and Marines. And to all who have died as a result of war. It is a time to remember those who suffered and died not just in the two world wars but also serving in wars and conflicts since then.

Remembrance is not only recalling and recounting what happened, with grief for the lives lost. It is also an annual reminder to let what has happened in the past inform and help us, individually, as communities and as nation. To enable us to act with wisdom, justice and discernment in the present and future, for the good and for the peace of all. While this is rarely simple or straightforward, we are called to be part of God's plan, acknowledging his rule now in our lives.
